Note: the sophomore semesters can be reversed, the junior semesters can be reversed, and the senior semesters can be reversed—unless the minor is one in which the final course is offered only in the fall (e.g., Creative Writing). Minors are optional, and if you choose to complete a minor, one course may count toward both the minor and the major with approval of the associate chair. (Such approval is not needed for a CWR or LNG course; either will be double-counted without approval.)

When you are exempted from something or when something double-counts, please note that your courses must still add up to 32 units.

You can easily add a second major or a minor. Note that 11 courses for the major + 9 for Liberal Learning + 3 for foreign language + 1 for Academic Writing = 24, and the requirement for graduation is 32. Most minors are only 5 courses. Most majors are 10-12 courses, but for a student with a double major or a major and an interdisciplinary concentration, the Liberal Learning responsibility is reduced to 7 courses (First Seminar + 1 in each of the categories of Math, Science, Social Science, History, Literary/Visual/Performing Arts, Philosophy/Religion) + Civic Responsibilities. Below is a sample schedule for a student with a double major in a Social Science field such as Sociology, and a sample schedule for a student with a minor such as Creative Writing.

Minors are optional, and if you choose to complete a minor, one course may count toward both the minor and the major with approval of the associate chair. (Such approval is not needed for a CWR or LNG course; either will be double-counted without approval.) Important: in order to complete the Creative Writing minor, students must contact the Creative Writing coordinator to discuss the requirements.

The English major requires a total of 11 courses, including 3 Literary History (1 before 1660) and 3 English Electives. When a course counts for both the major and the minor, or when you have transferred in a course that counts toward your English major or your minor, please note that your courses (including transfer credits, which are typically 16 units for an associate's degree) must still add up to 32 units.
