

For an English liberal arts major with an associate’s degree from a New Jersey community college:

Minors are optional, and if you choose to complete a minor, one course may count toward both the minor and the major with approval of the associate chair. (Such approval is not needed for a CWR or LNG course; either will be double-counted without approval.) Important: in order to complete the Creative Writing minor, students must contact the Creative Writing coordinator to discuss the requirements.

The English major requires a total of 11 courses, including 3 Literary History (1 before 1660) and 3 English Electives. When a course counts for both the major and the minor, or when you have transferred in a course that counts toward your English major or your minor, please note that your courses (including transfer credits, which are typically 16 units for an associate’s degree) must still add up to 32 units.

For an English secondary education major with an associate’s degree from a New Jersey community college:

This is a difficult schedule – virtually all of the student’s classes will be in one of her/his two majors, but with a summer LIT 499, it is possible to complete both the 11 course English major and the 10 course secondary education major in 5 semesters and one summer. If a student transfers in a single class to her/his English major or secondary education major, the dual English Secondary Education major may be completed in 5 terms, with careful planning. Be sure to talk this over with your advisor.
